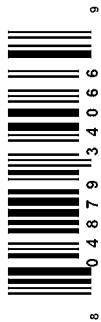

Superior Schools to resume in-person learning March 22

Beginning on Monday, March 22, Superior Unified School District will be offering in-person learning to all students kindergarten through high school, Monday-Friday. Parents/Guardians will need to communicate with each school site as to whether their student will be attending in-person or remote.

Remote learning will still be offered for students wanting to remain off campus. School officials highly encourage families to be consistent in deciding remote or in-person. Lunches will continue to be delivered to

students remaining in remote-learning. Please notify each school site if you DON'T want a lunch delivered for you child(ren).

The mask mandate is still in effect. Masks must be worn on campus. SUSD will implement social-distancing to the greatest extent possible. Sanitizing and cleaning will continue to take place daily and as needed. Students are responsible for taking care of their assigned devices at all times.

Please don't send your child(ren) to school if they are

ill. The school will send them home. Do not send your child(ren) to school if there is a positive contact in their home. The school will send them home.

SUSD will have a special Board meeting on March 24 to decide on a four-day school week beginning next school year. Parents were asked to participate in a survey about this issue. Schools in surrounding districts have successfully transitioned to the four-day school week.

Arizona Water: Maintaining Tanks

Little known facts about how Superior residents and businesses get their water:

The pipeline that transports water from the desert wells west of Florence Junction is the highest pressure pipeline transporting water in the Arizona Water Company, delivery system, and quite possibly the water delivery system for Superior is one of the most complex in water delivery systems in Arizona.

Once the water is piped into Superior via the high-pressure pipeline, 26 miles, uphill to Superior, it is stored in the Queen Creek tank. Four days of water for the Town of Superior are stored in the large tank at the bottom of the canyon. The water is then pumped to the smaller tank on the hill then gravity fed into the homes and businesses in Superior.

Maintaining the tanks is critical to the long term sustainability of the water delivery infrastructure for Arizona Water. Every 14 years, the Arizona Water Company does a complete recoating of the Queen Creek tank. Work

commenced on the tank maintenance in February. Prior to the the work being started, the tank had to be emptied, which required a delicate equation of balance to ensure that the tank emptied, and the booster pumps sending water to Superior did not send too much. Company officials stated that they were able to empty the tank without wasting much water. The tank holds 500,000 gallons of water. The Queen Creek tank was constructed using rivets, which is another reason the tank requires re-coating to make sure the tank remains solid. It is one of the only riveted tanks still in operation in the Arizona Water company system. The tank

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires Pinal County to publish an Annual Action Plan outlining the use of HUD funds for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), HOME, and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds.

All Pinal County citizens are invited to voice their comments regarding housing and community development needs, strategies to meet identified needs, and identifying barriers to those needs. Public input is an essential component of this planning effort. Pinal County, in conjunction with the cities and towns of Eloy, Florence, Mammoth, and Maricopa would like to invite you to a public meeting. The virtual meeting is to solicit ideas for potential projects. Projects must benefit low to moderate income residents and address one of the national objectives of the CDBG program. ESG funds must address the needs of persons experiencing homelessness. Information may be found on the Pinal County website www.pinal.gov/grants. Sample projects include public facilities infrastructure, housing, public services, transitional housing, shelter, rapid-rehousing, homelessness prevention. Pinal County will receive \$1,287,410 million in FY21 CDBG funding, \$612,860 in HOME funding, and \$156,877 in ESG funding. Each participating community will receive \$130,000.

was built in the late 1930s or 1940s, based on historic photos of the area. Re-coating requires the interior of the tank to be blasted and then coated with an epoxy coating. In addition to the re-coating, Arizona Water installed a new ladder to access the top of the tank, added new valves, new vents and manhole to allow for two entry exits for inspections and maintenance. Once the construction is complete, the tank will be inspected by a third party inspector before it is filled and then it will be re-inspected once the tank is filled. The work is expected to be completed in March.
